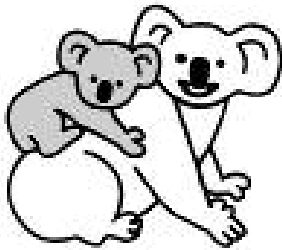

EUCALYPTUS CREBA	<i>Narrow-leaved ironbark</i>	Browse
EUCALYPTUS FIBROSA	<i>Broad-leaved ironbark</i>	Browse
EUCALYPTUS GRANDIS	<i>Flooded gum</i>	Browse
EUCALYPTUS MICROCORYS	<i>Tallowood</i>	Feed
EUCALYPTUS MOLUCCANA	<i>Grey box</i>	Browse
EUCALYPTUS PILULARIS	<i>Blackbutt</i>	Feed

EUCALYPTUS SEEANA	<i>Narrow-leaved red gum</i>	Browse
EUCALYPTUS SIDEROPHOLIA	<i>Qld grey ironbark</i>	Browse
EUCALYPTUS SIDEROXYLON	<i>Red ironbark</i>	Browse
EUEUCALYPTUS RESINIFERA	<i>Red Stringybark</i>	Feed
EUCALYPTUS ROBUSTA	<i>Swamp Mahogany</i>	Feed
EUCALYPTUS SALGINA	<i>Sydney Blue Gum</i>	Feed
EUCALYPTUS TERETICORNIS	<i>Forest red gum</i>	Feed
