It is a requirement that you not be currently working and agree to the following to be considered for a trainee-ship at Noosa & District Landcare:

- To be eligible you must be currently unemployed, under-employed, no longer at school, an Australian citizen, a Queensland resident, currently on the pathway to residency or a New Zealand resident.
- Be mindful of workplace healthy and safety and associated position risks, as instructed.
- Agree for NDLG to undertake a Police Check on you prior to employment.
- Be physically fit, willing and able to undertake manual work in a bushland and native plant nursery settings.
- Have no pre-existing injuries that would prevent you from doing manual work.
- Work constructively as part of a team of differing ages and abilities. We encourage a ‘spirit of co-operation.’
- Be respectful and considerate of your co-workers; and respectfully receive and carry out instruction from supervisors and team leaders.
- Have an interest in learning about the natural environment.
- Be committed to the training and position you are employed for, for the duration of the traineeship.
- Be reliable and turn up ready for work every work day; arrive on time; adhere to start times and break times. 7.00am to 3.30pm with ten minutes morning tea and half an hour for lunch.
- Do not be ***under the influence*** of **alcohol or any type of drugs** at work. You will be required to sign a commitment to this safety rule upon induction.
- Be respectful of place, property, community and country.
- Wear your uniform properly at all times, and respect the position of Noosa & District Landcare within the community.
